### A Caring Listener

Every year, the ministry receives hundreds of calls for prayer or for spiritual counseling. These calls are answered by our "Caring Listeners" -- volunteers who share their faith with TV viewers each week in the phone center for Words of Victory. Ministry staff and volunteers further respond to emails and letters from our broadcast and webcast programs. The ministry also provides coordination and training of counselors.



### Stephen Ministers

The Stephen Ministry is a structured program of one-on-one ministry that is designed to help "bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ" (Galatians 6:2). The Stephen Ministry program equips and empowers lay-caregivers (called Stephen Ministers) to provide high-quality, confidential, Christ-center care to people who are hurting.



### Technical Team

Our technical team is a group of dedicated individuals who volunteer their time and talents in the design, building, and maintenance of information technologies and key media-presentation systems utilized by the church. They provide the production of "The Victory Hour" and its distribution over the air and online.

### Ministry Partnerships



## ***“We are telling our world about Jesus.”***

*This statement is written on the lenses of the television cameras in the Worship Center as a constant reminder of our mission.*

For nearly 70 years, our church has utilized the medium of television to proclaim the “good news” of Jesus Christ to the people of Virginia. Grove Avenue Baptist Church pioneered the first regular television program in the Southern Baptist Convention of churches. The program that is known today as “The Victory Hour” has endured to become the longest-running Christian TV program in America.

“The Victory Hour” is broadcast live every week on Sunday mornings on NBC12 and carried on over 50 cable systems throughout the Commonwealth of Virginia. “The Victory Hour” is also webcast on **groveave.tv**, and the programs are posted to Facebook. Podcasts or audio-only versions of the pastor’s messages are also available on the church website. Today’s technology makes it possible for all of the church’s services to be seen around the world on mobile devices such as Smartphones and tablets. The broadcast of “The Victory Hour” and corresponding programs on the Internet have contributed greatly to the church’s influence and ministry impact for the cause of Christ.

Every week, through broadcasts and webcasts, it is “The Victory Hour” that serves to connect thousands of hearts and minds in a live worship experience built upon the Word of God and a personal and fulfilling relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ.



The ministry reaches many who are disabled or are otherwise homebound. It reaches those who are in hospitals and convalescent centers, including members of the church who may be recuperating from illness. “The Victory Hour” has reached into local jails and prisons and to places and to people where attending church is not possible.

Words of Victory is a 501c3 non-profit ministry organization that was created by the church to manage “The Victory Hour” broadcast and the response to viewers. The ministry itself is a unique partnership of pastors, who preach and teach from the Word of God, and volunteers, who serve in technical positions, or who help answer the phones. The ministry also draws upon supporters within the community of faith who pray for and contribute to the ministry to help with airtime and operational costs.
